### **House Rules**

 Ensure total guests matches that on your booking. If you have more guests than what you have booked for, you will not be covered under Airbnb Insurance. This is bad for everyone!

#### #3 - Check Out is 11 AM

#### #4 - Lights & Heating

 I would really appreciate if you could turn off all the lights and heaters when you leave the room each day, and on check-out.

### **Laundry**

While I don't have laundry facilities inside the apartment I have partnered with a laundry pick up and drop off company and you can find more information about their services in their booklet inside the drawer in the desk. Alternatively, there is an **Eco-Express** Laundromat located a short 550m away. Here you will find a full range of washing machines and dryers.

You will find hairdryers, shampoo, conditioner, and body wash in the bathrooms.

### **Restaurant Recommendations**

There are some lovely restaurants nearby which I recommend you check out. Below are some of my favorites, I hope you enjoy!

### **Spanish Tapas**

 Restaurant La Copa. They have amazing tapas, also great for vegetarians. (2km)

#### Mexican

Casita Mexicana has some of the best Mexican food in the city. (850m)

#### Thai Food

Sila Thai has some amazing authentic Thai food. (800m)

#### **German Pub Meal**

 Brauerei im Füchschen is tucked away in the northern part of Alstadt "Old Town" and offer up some great traditional German food and is the local brewery for the Alt beer and the home of the famous "pig knuckle". (4km)

#### **Japanese**

 Kushi-Tei of Tokyo, serves quality authentic Japanese food cooked and served by Japanese people. (1.3km)

#### Ramen

 Naniwa and Takumi are two of the best Ramen restaurants in Dusseldorf, you may have to wait in line, but trust me it's worth the wait. (1.4km)

#### Korean

Yoonsim serves amazing Korean BBQ and Korean food. (1km)

#### Steak

• The Classic Western Steakhouse. The best steak in the city. You will leave here with full and satisfied. (3km)

#### **Doner Kebab**

Dene & Gör. The best Doner Kebab in the city. (650m)

#### Vegetarian/Vegan

 Sattgrün. This is the best vegetarian/vegan restaurant in the city with an amazing range of options. (1km)



You will find plenty of tourist attractions in this city. Below are some of the most popular which are worth visiting during your stay here.

#### Museums

 There are plenty of great museums in this city. I definitely recommend checking out the K20 and K21 museums, while I also suggest checking out Museum Kunstpalast to learn about our cities history.

#### **Popular Tours**

 While you are in Dusseldorf you should check out Hop On Hop Off city tour. Guides will take you to all the popular spots and you will get some amazing photos on your journey. For more information please check the City Guide booklet in your room.

#### **Popular Areas**

 Be sure to check out Alstadt (Old Town), which is a popular hangout area in our city where you will find many restaurants, shops, bars, and nightclubs.

#### **Parks**

 Hofgarten Park is a great spot to visit during your stay. There is a lovely lake with plenty of wildlife, where you can have picnics.

### **City Pass**

The Düsseldorf Card is a perfect way to view the major attractions of our city at a discount rate. You'll receive discounts of up to 100% on around 50 offers, such as city tours, museums & souvenirs.

The Dusseldorf Card is the inexpensive and comfortable way to discover the Rhine metropolis. With this card you will be able to travel for free on public transportation in the city of Dusseldorf (including the airport) and have free reduced admission to numerous museums.

Experience city tours and sightseeing tours as well as cultural events at greatly reduced prices. Enjoy Dusseldorf's culinary scene and relax with sports and games. Our tip: Discover the magnificent panorama of the city from the boat.

A visit to Düsseldorf would not be complete without a visit to the shopping street. This city offers a huge range of shopping options.

### Königsallee "Kö"

 A popular street with boutique shops, along with cafes and restaurants. If you love shopping, then you will absolutely love Königsallee.

#### Alstadt "Old Town"

 Alstadt is also good for shopping, here you'll find all the popular brands just a few steps away from the bars and restaurants.

#### **G**roceries

• There is a Netto Marken-Discount supermarket (43m) a few doors down, it is a short 1 minute walk from the apartment, or if you're after something larger, check out Edeka at Zurheide Center (650m).

#### Carlsplatz

 Located south of Old Town, Carlsplatz is the oldest still operated marketplace in Düsseldorf. Here you will find a beautiful local market full of vendors selling everything from fresh fruits, flowers, wine, bread, cheese, and much more!

## **Pharmacy/Hospital /Emergency**

There is a pharmacy **Rheingold-Apotheke** (150m) 2 minutes walking distance from the apartment.

In case of emergency dial **110 for Police** and **112 for the Fire Brigade & Ambulance**. The closest hospitals are **Evangelical Hospital** (800m) and **St. Martin's Hospital** (1.8km).



While in Düsseldorf you will find plenty of transport options. Below are the best ways to get around the city:

#### **Trains**

The nearest tram station is a short 2 minute walk. If you wish to get to Düsseldorf Central Station, the nearest tram station is a short 4 minute walk and it is named Fürstenplatz.

#### **Taxis**

• If trains and busses are not your thing, taxis are another good option. Call 0211-33333 to book a taxi.

#### Uber

• The city now has Uber! It is a cheaper option to taxis and is often a better service too. Download the Uber app on your smart phone.

#### **Buses**

• The local bus is a great way to get around our city. The closest stop is 79m away.
